Fund objective and policy

The Fund aims to achieve long term capital growth and support sustainable development. The Fund is actively managed. It is not constrained by its comparator benchmark, the MSCI ACWI MID Cap NR Index, and has significant freedom to invest in a portfolio that is materially different to the benchmark's own composition. The Fund seeks to achieve its objective by investing in a diversified spread of equities of mid-capitalisation companies, maintaining adherence to defined sustainable criteria; including exclusions to tobacco, weapons, and fossil fuel reserves. Companies are identified through engagement opportunities aligned to the seventeen United Nations Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), which address issues including poverty, inequality, climate change, environmental degradation, prosperity, peace, and justice. 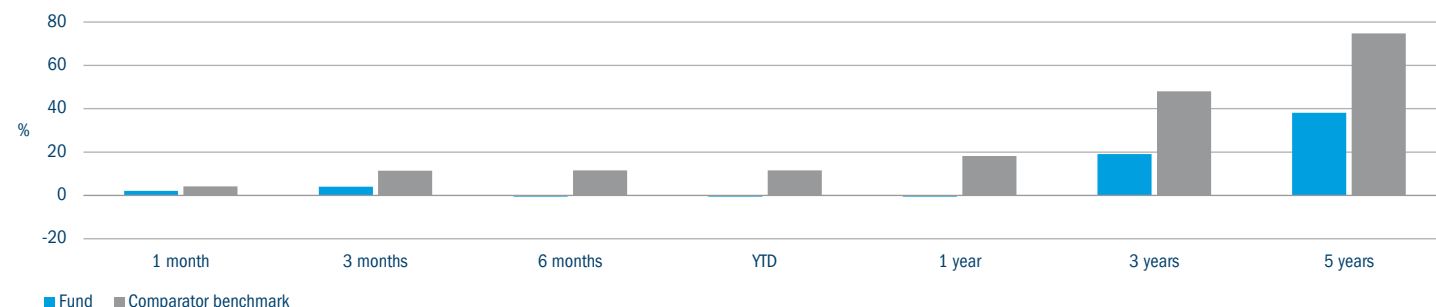
